What is Radiesse?

Radiesse is a type of Rejuvenate Filler, it is an injectable dermal filler that works by restoring facial volume, and reducing the signs aging. Once injected, it works with your body by stimulating the production of your own collagen which in turn, creates volume and definition.

What is the difference between Radiesse and Dermal Fillers?

Both products aim to reduce the signs of ageing by restoring facial volume. Dermal fillers give an instant result and patients can see results for 6-9 months. Radiesse works by making your own body stimulate collagen which giving you the fullness required. Results can take up to 3 months to show their full effect and results can last up to 18 months.

How will it be injected?

Radiesse like other fillers can be injected with a needle, however we use cannula to inject this product. This reduces post treatment swelling, reduces the risk of bruising and it allows us to place the product very specifically to give a natural result.

Will it hurt?

We mix Radiesse with a local anaesthetic making the procedure very comfortable, however you may feel a slight stinging as the anaesthetic takes effect, but we can also use a topical anaesthetic if required.

Where on the face is it used?

It can be placed in many different parts of the face and neck where there is a lack of volume and a slackness to the skin, however it is most commonly used in the cheeks, lower face and jaw line.

How do I know my practitioner is safe?
